The Complaint No. 490/2554: Right in Judicial Process, Case of Allegation against Police Officers committing robbery and seizure of property with unlawful practices;

Mr. Puripat Kulpanich, the Complainant lodged the Complaint to the National Human Rights Commission of Thailand (NHRCT) alleged that the police officers of the Bangsimuang Police Station, arrested the Complainant for indecent exposure alleging that Complainant muggings estate and seized his several items without record. The Complainant has also been forced to confess to a crime in other cases. Thus, he asked for the examination.

The National Human Rights Commission of Thailand (NHRCT) has acquired and considered the facts gained from examination of relevant laws and agreed that the delivery of the property, which was seized in the case, the Complainant possessing the property did not sign for the return property and there is no evidence to authorize any person to assume all return the property. For the return of property confiscated during the criminal proceedings, the officers should be required to perform duties properly and strictly based on the laws and regulations. To prevent disputes or litigation that may occur, therefore the NHRCT decided to report it to the National Police Office to determine the strong measures to restore the property and urged Office of the NHRCT to follow-up the implementation within 60 days.
